



ID CARDS FOR YOUR 72-HOUR KITS

- 1 Print page onto white cardstock (for more durability vs. paper) & cut out card.
- 2 Attach (with a good glue) your child's photo in the box - headshots are best!
- 3 Press your child's thumb into a rubber stamp ink pad, then press firmly in the corresponding thumbprint box.
- 4 Fill out the pertinent information. Use Social Security area at your discretion.
- 5 Flip the card over and glue a photo of your entire family and/or add other pertinent information about your child.
- 6 Laminate the card (school or office supply stores can help if you don't have a machine).
- 7 Punch a hole and use a keyring to attach to their assigned emergency bags. You can make copies for your bag, a family emergency binder, or school emergency kits.


